

Shake off the Cobwebs – Get Ready for Action – Lure Coursing is Back! Open to All Dogs!

Lure Coursing at Pawsitively Fun Training Center, Freeville, NY

Saturday June 5, June 19, 2010

Try your paw at lure coursing – the most fun your dog can have with a plastic bag! Lure coursing is a fast-paced chase sport. Dogs run after a "bunny" lure (a white plastic bag) that is attached to a line. They run in an open field and run as fast or slow as they want. This sport was developed for sight hounds, but many dogs love the thrill of the chase. If your dogs love to chase things, they will LOVE lure coursing! And even if you think they won't, you might be very surprised when your dogs go nuts for the lure!

Exactly how does it work? The simple answer is that we take a loop of string, stretch it out over a field on pulleys, attach a motor to make it move, and tie a plastic bag to the line. Start the motor and you have "Caffeine for Dogs".

There are no special skills or training required to start your dog in lure coursing. We just ask that you warm up your dog before coursing and cool down the dog after. This can be a simple five-minute walk on leash before and after.

***All dogs must be crated or leashed (Hang on Tight!) except when running, and must not be dog or people aggressive. Please Note: Prong, Electronic and Training (choke) collars are not allowed on premises.
